General Rules and Information

Rules: All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply: **Accreditation Number – A10 / 0007**

Eligibility: This tournament is open to **all TBA registered Junior Bowlers** under the age of 18 years as at 1/1/2010, and **Youth Bowlers** under the age of 23 years as at 1/1/2010. Membership cards or proof of purchase must be presented at check-in.

Dress Code: smart and tidy attire, collared shirts. Beach wear, tracksuit pants, singlet, rugby/stubby shorts, torn clothing and baseball caps will NOT be accepted. **Long** dress shorts may be worn.

Entering Averages: Highest average at 31st December 2009 – including all Leagues, Tournaments, Intercentre or Country Challenge, established over a minimum of 18 games in adult or junior competition, will apply. A bowler found with a higher TBA accredited average than their entering average can be re-graded. Averages will be checked at random.

No Average: A registered bowler who does not have a TBA accredited average or holds a higher average in a non-accredited league or Tournament will apply to the tournament committee for classification prior to submitting an entry.

Cost: Juniors - Entry fee of \$25.00 per bowler for each Teams, Doubles and Singles in the Championships.

All Events: All Events entry must pay a \$5.00 fee prior to bowling their 1st event, your **first attempt** in Trios, Doubles and Singles will become your All Events score. A Junior All Events champion will be declared for each grade, boys and girls.

Grading: Based on averages submitted, entries will be graded in accordance with the Tournament Grading Table.

Replacements: Any changes must be reported to the tournament office 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.

Check-in: Will be called 30 minutes prior to squad times.

Multiple Entries: Junior Bowlers may have unlimited attempts in Trios, Doubles and Singles provided there is lane availability.

Coaching: Will be permitted in the playing area by NCAS accredited coaches after presentation of accreditation to the tournament director.

Prizes: Trophies/medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for each grade in divisions for trios, doubles, singles, and all-events.

Intercentre Challenge:

Teams of 4 bowlers: boys, girls or mixed, will bowl two games. The total pinfall will decide winners. Non bowling clothes are to be worn with bowling shoes.

Masters and Classic Cup: A separate Masters Tournament, Open and Graded, and Classic Cup, with both Male and Female divisions is available. Juniors must complete an all-events entry to be eligible.

NSW U/23 Cup: Both male and female divisions, open to all bowlers under the age of 23 as at 01/01/2010. Qualifying is over 3 squads, re-entry available.

Challenge Shield: is contested by the two **NSW ZONES**, Southern and Northern, 2 divisions. Each Zone will nominate 2 boys and 2 girls team each division. A three game, **four** bowler team format, with head to head and overall pinfall point system will make up the scores for each **Division. Teams will be nominated by the NNSW and SNSW Shield Team Committees.**

Mobile Phones: All mobile phones must be switched off while competing in an event.

Additional Rules: Any rules not covered here shall be subject to a decision of the Tournament Director. All complaints will be in writing within 1hr of occurrence. The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse entry to any bowler if required.

Code of conduct – The Tournament Committee will follow and enforce the rules set down by Tenpin Bowling Australia Ltd - www.tenpin.org.au and NSW Child Protection in Sport.

2010 NSW Junior Open and Graded Masters

Eligibility:

Open to all TBA Registered Boys and Girls who have completed an All Events entry. **Graded Masters entering average: Boys 149 and under, Girls 139 and under.**

Qualifying:

Qualifying commences from first squad Saturday 20th to end 3.00pm squad Saturday 20th (Graded) and last squad Saturday 27th (Open). A bowler's qualifying score will be their highest **singles or doubles series** bowled in the 2010 NSW Junior Youth Championships. A once only **nomination fee of \$15.00** will be paid prior to a bowler's first qualifying attempt, for either Graded or Open Masters. A bowler may have unlimited attempts where squad times are available.

Graded Masters

Cost: \$70.00:

Finalists will pay \$70.00 for the final. All Finalists will receive a Masters Qualifier Medallion.

Finals:

The top 8 Boys and 8 Girls determined by the highest singles series bowled will compete in the final of the 2010 NSW Junior Graded Masters. In the event of a tie for 8th place the highest 3rd game of the qualifying series will determine 8th place.

Check-in: Sunday 21st February, 9.00am.

Bowlers will be called for check-in and if not present at 9.00 am will be replaced with the next highest reserve. There will be no excuses accepted. The centre clock will determine the time.

Format: All bowlers will play 8 games, with a lane change after each two game block. The bowler with the highest pinfall in both Boys and Girls division after the 8 games will be declared the 2010 NSW Junior Graded Masters Champion.

In the event of a tie for 1st place a further 1 game will be played by the equal first placed bowlers, if the tie still remains the 9th & 10th frames of the last game shall decide the winner.

Prizes:

Prize fund shall be disturbed as follows:

- 1st: \$200.00 Trophy and Shirt
- 2nd: \$100.00 and Trophy
- 3rd: \$ 50.00 and Trophy



****Area/Centre Champions will be accepted from TBA accredited Area/Centre Association Championships with a minimum of 6 qualifiers in Open Boy and Girl Open Master Events. Each Association must pay \$115.00 for individual entries by Thursday 12th February, 2010 and include proof of winning.**

Open Masters

Cost: \$100.00

Finalists will pay \$100.00 for the final. All Finalists will receive a Masters Qualifier Medallion.

Finals:

The top 24 boys and 16 girls including: the 2009 defending Champion Boy and Girl if eligible, Area / Centre Champions** and the next top qualifiers will fill the field. In the event of a tie highest 3rd game of qualifying series shall determine last qualifier.

Seeding: Number one will be the defending champion. The Area/Centre Champions and remaining qualifiers will be seeded according to their highest series bowled.

Check-in: Sunday 28th February, 8.30 am.

Bowlers will be called for check-in and if not present at 8.30 am will be replaced with the next highest reserve. No excuses will be accepted. The centre clock will determine the time.

Format: Stage One - Bowlers play 6 games with the highest 8 placed positions, in both boys and girls, continuing on. Pinfall carries over to next stage.

Stage Two - Top 8 bowlers will compete in a 7 game matchplay with added bonus of 20 pins for a win and 10 for a draw. The total pinfall plus bonus will determine the finishing positions.

Ties:

In the event of a tie in all stages of Final a 9th and 10th frame play-off will be bowled until the tie is broken.

Prizes:

Prize fund shall be disturbed as follows:

- 1st: \$ 500.00 Trophy and Shirt
Entry 2010 Australian Junior Open Masters
Entry 2010 Junior Sydney Cup
Right to defend 2011 NSW Junior Open Masters (if eligible)
- 2nd: \$ 300.00 and Trophy
- 3rd: \$ 200.00 and Trophy



2010 NSW Junior Classic Cup

Eligibility:

This event is open to all TBA Registered Boys and Girls who have completed an All Events entry, with an average of **170 and under for Boys and 160 and under for Girls.**

Qualifying:

Qualifying will commence first squad Saturday 20th February and end last squad on Saturday 27th February, 2010. A bowler's qualifying score will be their highest **singles or doubles series** bowled. A bowler may have unlimited attempts in qualifying, providing squad times are available.

A once only **nomination fee of \$15.00** will be paid prior to a bowler's first qualifying attempt.

The top 12 Boys and 12 Girls determined by the highest score will compete in the final of the 2010 NSW Junior Classic Cup. In the event of a tie the highest 3rd game of the qualifying series will determine last position.

Cost:

Finalists will pay \$80.00. All Finalists will receive a Classic Cup Qualifier Medallion.

Check-in: Sunday 28th February, 11.00 am.

Bowlers will be called for check-in and if not present at 11.00 am will be replaced with the next highest reserve. No excuses will be accepted. The centre clock will determine the time.

Final:

All bowlers will play 8 games, with a lane change after each two game block. The bowler with the highest pinfall in both Boys and Girls division after the 8 games will be declared the 2010 NSW Junior Classic Cup winner.

In the event of a tie for 1st place a further 1 game will be played by the equal first placed bowlers, if the tie still remains the 9th & 10th frames of the last game shall decide the winner.

Prizes:

The prize fund shall be disturbed as follows

- 1st: \$ 400.00 Trophy & Shirt
- 2nd: \$ 200.00 and Trophy
- 3rd: \$ 100.00 and Trophy
